2006 Clos de Bellecroix “Cuvée Marey”

“This domaine consistently turns out some of the best wines of the Côte Chalonnaise. This lovely Pinot shows fruit that is fully ripe but not at all obvious, with real delicacy and class but surprising depth and length for a light- to medium-bodied wine. Subtle accent notes of wild mushrooms, smoke and autumn leaves are very appealing, and this will pair up beautifully with dishes based on duck, pork or veal.”

2007 Clos St. Jacques

“A very discreet touch of pain grillé adds depth to the refined and elegant nose, in fact this is easily the most elegant wine among the three [Cuvée Marey, Clos St. Jacques and Clos La Folie] with acacia and lemon rind notes that are followed by rich, full and seductive medium-bodied flavors that possess plenty of dry extract that confers a sappy and palate coating texture to the lovely and energetic finish.
