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### 2009 Bourgogne Vieilles Vignes

*"An earthy and notably ripe dark berry fruit nose leads to mildly rustic middle weight flavors that possess good punch and unusually good finishing depth and length. This is an excellent Bourgogne and recommended."*

### 2009 Volnay Vieilles Vignes

*"A slightly more elegant nose offers up red and dark berry fruit trimmed in earth and stone notes, both of which continue onto the rich, textured and delicious medium-bodied flavors that deliver fine length."*

### 2009 Pommard Vieilles Vignes

*"As it typically is, this is more interesting than its Volnay villages counterpart with very pretty, fresh and ripe red currant and earth suffused aromas that complement well the rich, supple and utterly delicious medium-bodied flavors that are shaped by moderately firm tannins and excellent length. This is worth considering."*

### 2009 Volnay Les Fremiets

*"A deft touch of wood sets off an attractive mix of violets, wet stone and ripe red cherry aromas. The rich, full and seductively textured flavors possess excellent delineation and fine length. This is on the awkward side today as it hasn't fully harmonized but the underlying material is of sufficiently high quality that it should do so in time."*

### **2009 Volnay Les Champans**

*“A somber, serious and reserved nose features a dense array of dark berry fruit aromas that are nuanced by notes of iron-infused earth and wet stone. The rich, intense and relatively powerful flavors possess ample verve and excellent persistence on the decidedly firm finale. A classic Champans.”*

### **2009 Pommard Les Pezerolles**

*“An understated soupçon of wood does not interfere with the transparency of the pretty and ripe red pinot fruit, spice and earth aromas. The supple, round and beautifully detailed medium-bodied flavors possess plenty of dry extract that buffers the firm tannins on the mineral-inflected and impressively persistent finish. This should be lovely in time though prepare to wait at least a decade.”*

*“An extremely pretty and perfumed nose offers up dense red berry fruit aromas that complement rich, round and attractively textured flavors that possess excellent intensity and real drive on the balanced, complex and highly persistent finish.”*

### **2009 Pommard Les Rugiens**

*“An elegant and expressive nose of picture perfect red pinot and stone aromas merges seamlessly into detailed, pure, intense and harmonious flavors that also exude a fine minerality on the impeccably well-balanced and strikingly persistent finish. Textbook Rugiens built for the long haul even though the copious sap will allow this to be enjoyed young if desired.”*
